What have we been up to?


- It may have been our Christmas break, but we have been busy!

Scheme Updates:

- We are introducing *Bone Markers* as part of our Specimen Exchange Programme. Please contact us if you are interested in Serum P1NP, Serum Bone ALP, Serum Osteocalcin and Plasma CTx. Specimens will be dispatched with the UK NEQAS for Vitamin D specimens, but bimonthly.
- We have had our second distribution of the UK NEQAS for Ammonia Scheme. We are really pleased with the results! Our Extension to Scope Assessment to ISO/IEC 17043:2023 with UKAS is in a few weeks!
