## Scheme Updates:

- UK NEQAS for Clinical Chemistry Distribution 1190 is the last fortnightly distribution for those participants that have moved to the UK NEQAS for Monthly Clinical Chemistry from 2025–2026.
- We are implementing GIRFT Pathology Recommendation 13, demonstrating 'How EQA data can be used to support better clinical outcomes'. At UK NEQAS for Clinical Chemistry Distribution 1190 and UK NEQAS for Monthly Clinical Chemistry Distribution 191 we are looking at calcium, albumin and adjusted calcium. We encourage you to read the flyer with your specimens and take part!
- Please look at your UK NEQAS for Steroid Hormones report for Distribution 527. There is significant variation in the interpretation of Short Synacthen test results!! What are the laboratories going to do about this?
